- ▶ Proverbs 1:7: "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction."

- ▶ Embrace best practices by seeking God's wisdom and guidance

Embracing a Global and Diverse Context

- ▶ Revelation 7:9: Vision of diverse peoples worshipping God together
- ▶ Contemporary example: Christian universities welcoming and including diverse cultures and perspectives
- ▶ Public Universities diverse
- ▶ Move beyond recruitment to true intercultural learning and respect

Balancing Tradition and Innovation

- ▶ Respect the historic Christian faith, including spiritual disciplines like prayer and contemplation
- ▶ Innovate in education technology, pedagogy, and research approaches
- ▶ Example: Use of online learning enriched with Christian formation practices

Developing Intercultural Competence

- ▶ Biblical call to love and serve all neighbors, including those from different backgrounds (Luke 10:25-37, Good Samaritan)
- ▶ Prepare students to navigate and engage pluralistic societies effectively
- ▶ Contemporary example: Cross-cultural immersion and service programs building culturally intelligent leaders

Integrating Biblical Justice and Scholarship

- ▶ Micah 6:8: "Do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with your God."
- ▶ Address real-world issues in scholarship: social justice, poverty, environment, peace
- ▶ Example: Christian social work and community development programs impacting local and global needs

Spiritual Commitment and Prayer

- ▶ 1 Thessalonians 5:17: "Pray without ceasing."
- ▶ Commit to prayer as foundation for embracing best practices and innovation
- ▶ Example: Prayer meetings among staff seeking God's vision and unity

Some Specifics (Teaching Staff)

- ▶ Set exam questions and marking scheme at the beginning of the semester
- ▶ Start lectures on first day
- ▶ Update lecture notes regularly
- ▶ Publish at least once a year
- ▶ Get a research grant once in three years
- ▶ Engage in community service
- ▶ Effective use of AI
- ▶ Attend Conferences



Some Specifics (Non-Teaching Staff)


- ▶ Punctuality is the soul of business
